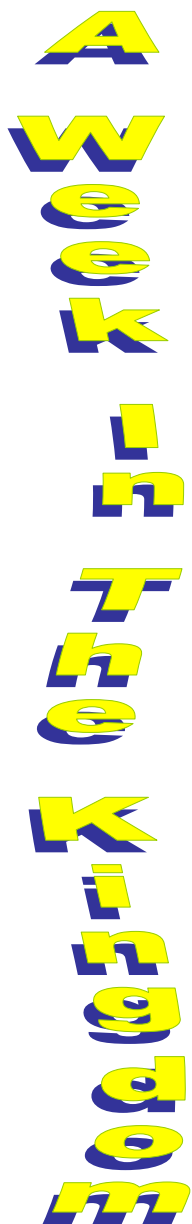

2015 -2016 Copy Machine Allocation GKHS Teacher Work Center (Library)

Nine-week copy allocations have been increased to the following:

1st 9-week allocation 3,000 = 1500 per machine

Adding 1000 = 500 per machine

2nd, 3rd, and 4th 9-week allocations 4,000 = 2000 per machine

Teachers may purchase copies using school funds through one or more of the following sources. See Ms. Hauer, School Business Manager, for purchases. No refunds will be given for unused copies.

- 1) Use their \$40.00 semester allotment to purchase copies

\$40.00 = 4000 copies or 2000 copies per machine

\$30.00 = 3000 copies or 1500 copies per machine

\$20.00 = 2000 copies or 1000 copies per machine

Cornerstones of ELL Education By Ms. Garza, GKHS ESL Department

Making a habit of incorporating ELL strategies into instruction can be as simple as implementing some simple supports such as slowing down the pace of whole group instruction, scaffolding concepts and reducing teacher talk time so that students can focus on more hands on activities. The following is taken from *Covering Complex Ground with ELL Students*, by Scott Sterling:


Use multiple mediums, especially with new vocabulary

Your first bit of common sense is this: ELL students struggle during lectures. Wherever possible, and especially when introducing new vocabulary, vary your presentation media. Visuals go a long way here. It's much more likely that someone new to the language will grasp a new word if they can see a picture or video of what you're talking about. This is why flipping the classroom makes a lot of sense in these cases.

Use more graphic organizers

Graphic organizers are a key tool both in mainstream education and for ELL students. It allows language learners to graphically arrange new ideas in a way that might make more sense to them than just traditional note taking. Don't forget to use graphic organizers in the room as well. ELL students respond well to word walls and big posters because it gives them a stress-free way to reinforce vocabulary and concepts learned on previous days.

Collaborative learning is key

Naturally, students are more comfortable with each other than they are with you. Have the kids work together to solve problems and compare ideas as much as possible. It's a great way for the ELL student(s) to be included without any sort of performance anxiety. Think-Pair-Share works great here, but make sure the partnerships are switched up every so often so the language learner has more practice with various people.

Allow them to be physical rather than verbal

Verbal expression lags behind comprehension for a lot of ELL students. They may understand what is being taught but still struggle to discuss or present as a way to demonstrate that comprehension. This is where you can exercise your creativity. Where you might have normally given a written assessment, shake things up and have the students produce a video or skit to demonstrate their understanding. The ELL students will feel more productive and the mainstream students will be more likely to retain the knowledge.

School-wide Professional Development

School-wide professional development is an ongoing system of providing support and planning resources for teachers. Each month has a targeted focus that relates to the greater school-wide mission and vision. School-wide P.D. also provides an opportunity for inter-departmental collaboration and communication.

Department Meetings

During department meetings we will dispense important information, discuss resources, and strategies that apply content wide.

Content-specific Collaborative Planning

During collaborative planning we will compare data, create common plans including assessments and activities, and continue to develop long-term plans.

Targeted Professional Development

Targeted Professional Development sessions will be designed to respond to needs identified by various stakeholders and instruct teachers on best practices to resolve or address these specific needs. Teachers will be responsible for implementing these best practices within a timeframe discussed at the session.

IS Lateral Planning

IS lateral planning meetings will provide IS teachers with detailed instructions for lesson plan implementation and guidance. Grade level Leaders will gather feedback and data from IS teachers who have implemented previous lessons. Lesson plans and materials will be provided to assist teachers in student growth in terms of appropriate level standardized tests.

ESL Department Meeting Focus: ESL Department meetings will continue to focus on ELL Accommodations. This will make both the ESL and mainstream teacher more effective by providing the necessary strategies to support students. Students will achieve academic success through the implementation of individualized accommodations outlined on their ACE form. Deliverables: ESL Teachers will provide the ACE form for mainstream teacher signatures. Mainstream teachers will complete signatures and consult with Lead ESL Teacher for their student for support. ESL Department Chair will submit agenda 24 hours in advance to the Supervising Administrator and the signature page post meeting.

ESL Collaborative Meetings: ESL Teachers will meet with their course team (ESL I, II, Content Areas – Geography, ELA, Reading) to develop course outline and materials. Deliverables: Submit Lesson Plans according to calendar cycle.

ELL / ESL Department Grade Level Meeting

ESL Teachers will continue to focus on providing students with the accommodations they require, as per their ACE Accommodations. Teachers will discuss how to implement these accommodations in their class rooms which will provide students with the support they need to prepare themselves for the ELDA exams. Students will be advancing their English proficiency, in the areas that they are weakest in, through practice in the classroom.

Deliverables: Provide an outline of the materials being used to meet ACE accommodations for each English Proficiency Level, as it pertains to ELDA test preparation, which will allow for collaborative planning between ESL teachers.
