After 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, October 17, teachers will no longer have the ability to enter grades in their WebGradebook for the first nine weeks.



We believe that field trips are an essential component of a quality education, and we recognize that it takes a great deal of planning to organize and execute a meaningful experience. We also recognize that EOC/LEAP 2025 testing is high priority for both students and teachers. In order to ensure adequate preparation and review time as we draw closer to our testing dates, there is a timeline that must be adhered to when planning student field experiences.

- The deadline for fall semester field trip requests is Friday, October 27, 2017
- No field trips may occur between Monday, November 13th to the close of the semester
- Field trips may resume upon return from winter break

These will both be year-long SLTs, regardless of whether you teach a full year or semester course.



If you teach the same course during the fall and spring semesters, you must write two (2) SLT's for all students enrolled in your course during both the fall and spring semesters.

- 1) TCA whole-class (whole year)
- 2) Your second SLT must come from one of the following options:
 - TCA whole-class for a different course (whole year)
 - TCA small group (whole year)
 - ACT whole class (guidance pending)

Grace King Guidance for ESL Teachers, SPED Teachers, Health/PE Teachers, and Read 180 Teachers If you teach the same course during the fall and spring semesters, you must write two (2) SLT's for all students enrolled in your course during both the fall and spring semesters. You should follow district guidance for these SLTs.

You will receive a reply indicating whether or not your request to conduct you activity outdoors has been approved.

All students must leave campus at the 2:40 bell unless they are under the direct supervision of a coach, sponsor, or teacher. Remember, if students are staying with you for tutoring or an activity, they are your responsibility until they leave campus.
