The Metairie Business Development District (MBDD), Jefferson Chamber Foundation (JCF) & Fat City Friends invite the media to attend the unveiling of 7 murals, measuring 56 linear feet, which 16 Grace King students painted during the Spring 2017 semester as part of the Talented Visual Arts Program. These murals will be installed along the northeast corner of the Entergy substation located at Edenborn and West Esplanade as Jefferson Parish completed the Edenborn drainage project. *On Tuesday September 26th around 3:30 PM, at the intersection of Edenborn and West Esplanade, community stakeholders will unveil the murals created by these gifted students.*

"The fence murals are yet another sign of the creativity and vitality blossoming in the new Fat City," said Jefferson Parish District 3 Councilwoman Jennifer Van Vrancken.

On Monday, November 14, 2016, representatives of Entergy presented a check to the Metairie Business Development District and the Jefferson Chamber Foundation for an improvement project in the Fat City area. The project, which began in January, involves installation of murals along the Entergy substation at the corner of West Esplanade and Edenborn Ave. The panels will have murals designed and painted by members of the Grace King High School's talented visual arts program classes, supervised by instructor Tracey Bullington.

Melanie Stewart, Director of Customer Service for Entergy Louisiana stated, "Entergy is pleased to partner with the community to support economic development and enhance education in our community. It's projects like this that bring us together to improve the quality of life in the communities we serve."

Sixteen students from Grace King's talented visual art program were chosen to participate in the project and spent months brainstorming, sketching, and revising their designs for the murals seven panels. Students chose to represent the people, animals and scenes that, in their opinions, make Fat City unique and memorable. Students worked in small groups and were each assigned a panel to complete, although they also carefully considered how the panels look together as one complete and cohesive design. The following are the students who are involved in the project: Maria Ballesteros, Syed Basit, Jazelle Burton, Crystal Chan, Chase Cunningham, Amber Drumm, Halana Gegenheimer, Demir Hajdarevic, Emily Kuylen, Ja'Diah McCray, Tiffany Perdomo, Elaina Proffitt, Anna Sanabria, L Spaziola, Kelsae Tracek, and Xiao Zhang.

Entergy provided \$10,000.00 for the installation of the murals, art supplies, and weatherproofing to ensure that the murals will last for years to come. The MBDD, JCF & Fat City Friends are funding the remainder of the project and Helm Paint & Supply has provided the paint and other equipment free of charge. Principal Engineering, Inc. provided the engineering services as an in-kind donation and David Art Center offered a discount to the students involved while purchasing equipment or paint for this project.

The purpose of this form is to ensure all necessary protocols and procedures are followed when conducting a fundraiser.

Any time money or goods are collected by your organization for the purpose of generating revenue, approval is required. This includes t-shirt sales, ticket sales, concession sales (including for games), bake sales, lazer tag nights, etc.

This checklist must be completed and initialled by the person indicated in parenthesis.

_____ Check availability of the proposed dates for the fundraiser and obtain a Fundraising Sales Report. (Torrado)

_____ Fill out the top portion of the Fundraiser Sales Report and submit for approval. (Hauer)

_____ You will receive a copy of the Fundraiser Sales Report in your mailbox within 5 days. It will be stamped either “approved” or “not approved.” (Teacher/Coach/Sponsor)

_____ Conduct your fundraiser within the approved timeline indicated at the top of your Fundraiser Sales Report. (Teacher/Coach/Sponsor)

_____ Ensure that daily deposits are made for all money collected on each day of the fundraiser. (Hauer)

_____ Once the fundraiser is complete, submit both the Fundraiser Sales Report and this form within 10 days (including weekends and holidays) of the end date listed on the sales report. (Hauer)

***Note: This form must be turned in before a new fundraiser may be approved.**

ATTENTION CLUB SPONSORS – K. Torrado

Your official club charters and any events for the fall semester are due on September 30th. After this date, club will not be able to operate without a charter. Also, if you have not submitted your meeting dates and times, please do so by Friday, September 22nd.

Clubs that are interested in meeting at lunch time may do so on **Wednesdays only**. Please inform me of the potential of any lunch meetings so that a special pass can be created for your students that will allow them access to the building.

This is so we are able to monitor traffic in and out of the buildings during teacher lunch times. If you as a sponsor plan to hold meetings at lunch, please be respectful of your colleagues by monitoring meeting activities.

To ensure safety, you must follow these guidelines:
