

Senior Second Line Information

For those of you who are new to our campus, it is tradition that the senior class makes a final walk through the hallways before exiting the campus as students for the last time. We call this our Senior Second Line. The band will play and seniors will walk along the long hallways that extend down the sides of the 200 and 300 buildings, across the front porch and through the courtyard. They will also walk down the front English and Math halls and the back social studies hall. In order to ensure a successful experience for all, please adhere to the following:

1. The second line will begin between 1:15 and 1:30. DO NOT ISSUE PASSES BETWEEN 1:10 AND THE END OF THE SECOND LINE FOR ANY REASON.

2. If the second line is passing directly in front of your classroom, students must stay INSIDE of the classroom. They may stand in the door ways to watch, but they should not leave the room for ANY REASON.

3. If your classroom is not in the path of travel, (This applies to Ms. Baxter's hallway, Mr. Ledoux's hallway, Mr. DaSilva Gonske's hallway, the 400, and 600 buildings), your students may view the second line from the end of the hallway. However, teachers should stand in front of their students to ensure that no underclassmen attempt to join the second line.

4. Students may want to stop briefly to give you a hug or say goodbye. This is fine, but encourage them to move along quickly because we need to keep the line together and moving.

5. Once the second line passes, return students immediately to your classrooms. Take role in order to ensure that all of your students have been accounted for.
