



Senior Class of 2018 Career Technical Education Agreement

Career Technical Education (CTE), formerly known as Early Release, is a career readiness program available to select seniors. In order to qualify for CTE, a current senior must meet the following criteria:

- Score 21 or higher on the ACT
- Provide proof of employment
- Possess a schedule that shows work hours start before end of school day
- Have completed or be currently scheduled in a dual-enrollment or AP class
- Have transportation from campus

A student who is allowed to enroll in CTE must continue to hold employment the duration of each semester and provide proof of employment each month with copies of their paystubs. Failure to maintain a job or provide documentation can adversely affect their class grade and GPA and will result in withdrawal from the program and subsequent withdrawal of permission to leave campus at the conclusion of their academic schedule.

A student who is allowed to enroll in CTE must maintain full-time status and maintain satisfactory attendance in all classes on campus and at their respective place of employment. Full-time is defined as equal to 4 credit hours per semester. Students with only two classes must enroll in CTE. Students may not miss more than five days of classes each semester, and they may not work over the maximum of hours as stated by Louisiana law.

A student who is allowed to enroll in CTE must remain in good academic standing with a minimum 2.0 GPA. Failure to maintain the minimum GPA will result in removal from the program and permission to leave campus at the conclusion of their academic schedule.

A student who is allowed to enroll in CTE recognizes that this is an extension of the curriculum and is required to adhere to the expectations as set forth by Grace King and their respective employer. Failure to do so will result in removal from the program and permission to leave campus at the conclusion of their academic schedule.
